# **CONSERVATION COMMISSION'S ACTION**

# **Approve Minutes**

**VOTED** (4-0-1), Robb, Allen, Gerber, Stein voted "Aye," Kaplan abstained to approve the Conservation Commission minutes of February 27, 2008.

**VOTED** (4-0-1), Allen, Gerber, Kaplan, Stein voted "Aye," Robb abstained to approve the Conservation Commission minutes of March 26, 2008.

### **PERMITS/CERTIFICATES**

Request for Determination of Applicability (RFD 08-1110) – Amherst Conservation Department for replacement of bog bridging located on Station Road (Map 21C, parcel 27; Map 24A, parcels 44 & 45).

- Opened the public hearing at 7:32 p.m.
- Closed the public hearing at 7:40 p.m.

David McKinnon presented for the Amherst Conservation Department and distributed photos of bog bridging in various states of deterioration.

**VOTED** unanimously (5-0), to close the public hearing and to issue a negative determination for the work.

**7:40 PM - Request for Determination of Applicability (RFD 08-1111)** – Skyline Builders for construction of a single family house, driveway and associated utilities in the buffer zone of Bordering Vegetated Wetlands located on Stanley Street (Map 18A, parcel 14).

- Opened the public hearing at 7:48 p.m.
- Closed the public hearing at 8:00 p.m.

John Kopinsky presented for the applicant. Stephanie Ciccarello, Wetlands Administrator, read special conditions to be imposed.

**VOTED** unanimously (5-0), to close the public hearing and to issue a negative determination for the work with special conditions as follows:

- 1. Erosion control shall be continued along the western edge of the property boundary to more efficiently contain potential sediment migration
- 2. Erosion control shall be carefully installed at the western edge around the tree so as to prevent damage to tree roots.

- 3. Erosion control shall serve as the limit of work.
- 4. Stawbales and straw shall be used in lieu of haybales and hay to prevent the spread of invasive seed.
- 5. The Wetlands Administrator shall be notified upon installation of the erosion control at least 48 hours prior to construction
- 6. A portable toilet shall be on site during construction.
- 7. Proposed fencing shall be raised 1 ½' above ground to allow movement of wildlife.
- 8. Fencing shall be moved between 10' 15' to the north to be out of priority habitat area.
- 9. Receipt of a revised plan by the Commission is required prior to work.

**Request for Determination (RFD 08-1107)** (Cont'd from 3/26/08) – Richard Brazeau for DCR for construction of two vehicle storage garages with parking areas and associated grading at 51 Military Road, Amherst (Map 28A, Parcel 3).

- Opened the public hearing at 8:01 p.m.
- Closed the public hearing at 8:05 p.m.

Rich Brazeau was present and indicated that the DCR has not yet received an NHESP impact letter.

**VOTED** unanimously (5-0), to close the public hearing and to issue a negative determination for the work with the condition that straw bales be used instead of hay bales.

**Notice of Intent (NOI-08-1109)** (Cont'd from 3/26/08) – Gordon Hall for clearing of brush and invasive shrubs and vines in the upland and buffer zone area and planting of agricultural crops and/or black walnut or other hardwood saplings located at Thrush Lane, Amherst (Map 18C, Parcels 49-66)

- Opened the public hearing at 8:06 p.m.
- Closed the public hearing at 8:35 p.m.

**VOTED** (5-0-1), Robb, Allen, Gerber, Kaplan, Stein voted "Aye," Baker abstained to close the public hearing and to issue an Order of Conditions with special conditions as cited by the Wetlands Administrator:

- 1. A plan shall be submitted with flagpoints: permanent markers indicated prior to work.
- 2. Should access over conservation land be denied, a separate NOI shall be submitted for access from Old Farm Road which shall include a surveyed plan of the crossing location and a minimum of 1:1 replication
- 3. A winter cover crop shall be planted to stabilize disturbed soils

**VOTED** unanimously (6-0), to adjourn the open session and to convene an Executive Session.

#### **MISCELLANEOUS**

### **Informal Discussion – Bog Bridging**

Dave McKinnon gave a PowerPoint presentation on trail maintenance and bog bridging (foot-trail) maintenance. Dave Ziomek also spoke to the issue as well.

### **Access to Thrush Lane - Discussion**

Dave Ziomek presented his position on access across the Wentworth Farm Conservation Area and KC Trail to the Hall property; a discussion of the concerns ensued. The Commission agreed that a written license agreement should be drawn up. Mr. Ziomek will work with Town Counsel to create such a license agreement.

**VOTED** (5-1), Robb, Allen, Gerber, Kaplan and Stein voted "Aye," Baker voted "Nay" to request that the Conservation Director work with Town Counsel to create a license agreement for access across the Wentworth Farm Conservation Area and KC Trail to the Hall property.
