**Public Hearing – WMECO**

- VOTED unanimously to approve, pending permit from the Department of Public Works, the petition from Western Massachusetts Electric Company to install and maintain underground cable including the necessary sustaining and protecting fixtures along and across the following public way as indicated in WMECO plan marked 6A250222:  
**Teawaddle Lane** - install approximately 178 feet of primary underground cable north of Rolling Ridge Road.

**Street Closing and Relaxed Parking Enforcement – Taste of Amherst**
