ADD the following areas to the Town Center Permit Parking Area:

Cowles Lane ~ Beginning at North Prospect Street and proceeding eastward approximately 250 feet along the south side of the street.

Pray Street parking lot ~ twenty (20) spaces in the westerly half of the Pray Street parking lot (excepting an existing handicapped parking space).

Stop Sign

VOTED unanimously (4-0) to approve the installation of a stop sign on South Prospect Street at Northampton Road.

Sign State Primary Warrant

VOTED unanimously (4-0) to sign the September 17, 2002 State Primary warrant.
