SELECT BOARD'S ACTION

Public Hearing – Parking Regulations

- Public hearing called to order at 7:27 p.m.
- Closed the public hearing at 8:12 p.m.
- VOTED: Harvey, Schiffer, Jolly, Seppala voted “Aye”, Boss “No”, to approve the following changes to the Parking Regulations:

NO PARKING AREAS:

Prohibit parking on Churchill Street (College Avenue) from Main to Lessey Streets.

LOADING/UNLOADING ZONES:

Establish a commercial loading/unloading zone from 40 to 50 Main Street between the hours of 6:30 a.m. and 11:30 a.m.

Establish a commercial loading/unloading zone from 37 to 57 North Pleasant Street between the hours of 6:30 a.m. and 11:30 a.m.

METER CHANGES:

CHANGE the parking time limitation from 1 hour to 20 minutes on meters located at 40 – 50 Main Street.

CHANGE the parking time limitation from 1 hour to 20 minutes on meters located at 37 – 43 North Pleasant Street.

CHANGE the parking time limitation from 1 hour to 20 minutes on four meters located in the southwestern corner of the Lower Bangs Lot.

CHANGE all one hour parking time limitation to two hours.

NO ACTION TAKEN ON THE FOLLOWING:

Prohibit parking on Kellogg Avenue from North Pleasant to Smith Streets.

Establish a commercial loading/unloading zone from 4 to 8 Main Street between the hours of 6:30 a.m. and 11:30 a.m.
