SELECT BOARD'S ACTION

Public Hearing – WMECO – Main and North Whitney Streets

- Public hearing called to order at 6:24 p.m.
- VOTED unanimously to grant permission to Western Massachusetts Electric Company to install on Main Street approximately 50 feet of primary underground cable southwesterly of North Whitney Street and on North Whitney Street approximately 208 feet of primary underground cable northerly of Main Street. Work to begin after April 3, 2000.

Mike's Westview Cafe Management Plan

2. There will be postings inside the establishment which instruct patrons to come and go in an orderly fashion and that no containers may be taken outside.
3. The doormen and bartenders on duty will be responsible for information and enforcement of said postings.
