SELECT BOARD'S ACTION

Coin Drop – Amherst Fire Department

VOTED unanimously to approve the request of the Amherst Fire Department to have a Coin-Drop for Muscular Dystrophy on September 3, 2000, from 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at the intersection of Main and South Pleasant Streets, subject to the Police Chief's condition that soliciting must be done on the sidewalks and must not impede traffic.
