

**Amherst Leisure Services and Supplemental Education Commission Minutes**

**Minutes of May 16, 2012**

The minutes were approved with an amendment regarding the picnic pavilion agenda item. Groups reserving the pavilion have first right of usage and their LSSE Department issued permit serves as evidence of their reservation. If the group is loud and unruly then the police can be contacted. AB Winograd made the motion and J. Foster provided the second. The motion was unanimously approved as amended.

**War Memorial Pool Rededication**

M. Whittemore reported that some but not all of the original plans for the pool rededication might be available for the postponed rededication. At the time it was not known when the rescheduled rededication would take place.

**Schedule and School Use of Community Field**

S. Ziomek raised concerns about the use of Community Field by the School. He also stated if Community Field is damaged by the School they should pay for repairs. This discussion led to concerns about the Town's lack of use of the Middle School Pool. S. Ziomek volunteered to initiate further discussions about the Middle School Pool with the Town Manager.

**Conservation Dog/Leash Decision**

The Commission discussed the recent ruling by the Conservation Commission on the dog/leash policy. The Conservation Commission is planning to extend the trial period on the policy for another 3 months.

**Fields/Recreation Areas Conditions Report**

In J. Patulak's absence, S. Ziomek handed out J. Patulak's report of the current maintenance issues for the recreation areas.

**Peddler's at Recreation Areas**

AB Winograd moved and M. Whittemore seconded that there be no soliciting on the Town park land for commercial benefit. The motion was unanimous

**Director's Report**

L. Chalfant provided her monthly department report which included information on staffing, programs, outreach and capital projects. Handouts were provided.

The next meeting was set for July 18, 2012. Topics to discuss included Town LSSE and School coordination and girl's sports programs.
