FY 07 Budget Recommendations

Article 26 - FY 2007 Operating Budget

VOTED unanimously to recommend FY 2007 Operating Budget – General Government in the amount of \$5,300,392.

VOTED unanimously to recommend FY 2007 Operating Budget – Public Safety in the amount of \$7,966,001.

VOTED unanimously to recommend FY 2007 Operating Budget – Public Works in the amount of \$1,755,944.

VOTED unanimously to recommend FY 2007 Operating Budget – Planning/Conservation/Inspection in the amount of \$898,047.

VOTED: Awad, Hubley, Kusner, Weiss voted “Aye”, Greeney abstained, to recommend FY 2007 Operating Budget – Community Services in the amount of \$1,811,558.

VOTED unanimously to recommend FY 2007 Operating Budget – Debt Service in the amount of \$1,774,492.

VOTED unanimously to recommend FY 2007 Operating Budget – Water Fund in the amount of \$3,722,592.

VOTED: Awad, Hubley, Kusner, Weiss voted “Aye”, Greeney “No”, in anticipation of additional State Aid, to support increasing Elementary Schools budget by up to \$144,000 above the 3.6% Finance Committee guideline.

VOTED unanimously to recommend FY 2007 Operating Budget – Sewer Fund in the amount of \$3,232,035.

VOTED unanimously to recommend FY 2007 Operating Budget – Solid Waste Fund in the amount of \$473,497

VOTED: Awad, Hubley, Kusner, Weiss voted “Aye”, Greeney “No”, to recommend FY 2007 Operating Budget – Transportation Fund in the amount of \$920,199.
