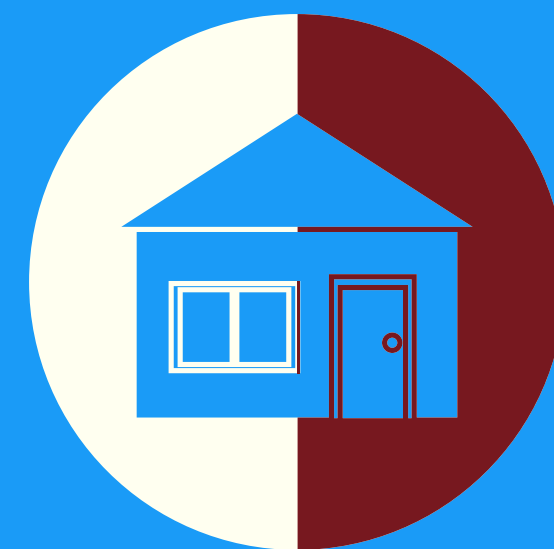
VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINES



- **Wednesday August 15th:** Deadline to Register to vote in the September 4th State Primary/Town Council Preliminary Elections
- **Wednesday October 17th:** Deadline to Register to vote in the November 6th State General/Town Council Elections

Students have a choice about where to register to vote. You may register at your local Amherst address or choose to remain registered at your permanent address. **You may only be registered to vote in one location.**

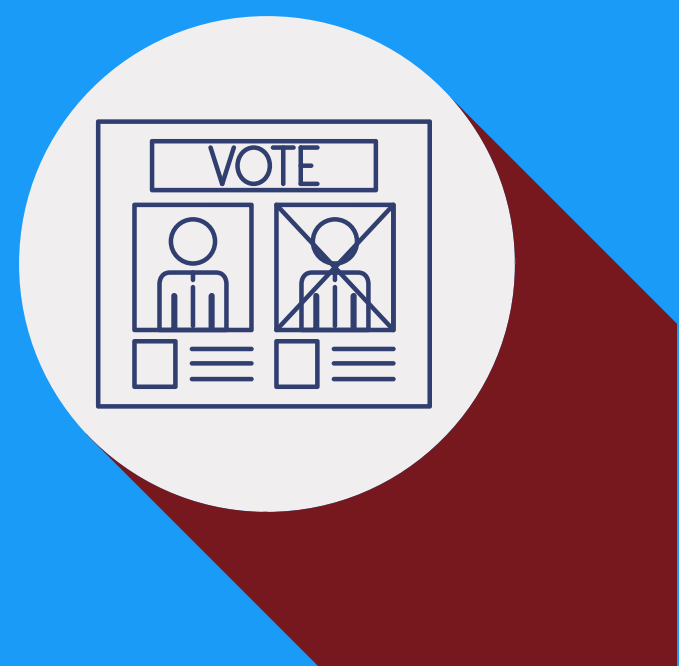
