## Ways you can shorten Town Meeting

- **Become familiar with articles on the warrant before Town Meeting.**
  - See below for hints about how to become informed.
- **Post your back-table documents to the TM listserv.**
  - Send your document as an email attachment to <townmeeting@amherstma.gov> and include the article number your document references.
- **Prepare and submit amendments to articles well in advance.**
  - Send amendments to the Moderator at <moderator@amherstma.gov> at least a day before the session and bring four copies to the Moderator before the session begins.
- **Be in your seat by 7:30pm.**
  - The average recent start time has been 7:40pm, costing a full hour of time after only six sessions.
- **Use your red and green tally cards to help the moderator guide debate.**



## Where to get information about warrant articles:



### In person or on paper

- Attend the Warrant Review on Thursday, April 14 or watch a rebroadcast of it on ACTV or at <amherstmedia.org>.
- Attend a precinct meeting (see schedule in your Town Meeting packet).
- Read the board and committee reports in your packet.
- Visit the Jones Library to read archived information or check out videos of previous events including informational forums on the budget, smart growth, and human services.
