When yard debris ends up in the street, sidewalk, and storm drains, it contributes nutrients to stormwater runoff, which causes serious water quality issues!

Leave grass clippings where they fall to decompose and naturally fertilize your lawn.

Or compost grass clippings or use as mulch.



DON'T blow or place yard debris in the street, sidewalk, storm drain, wetland or water body!



DO compost your grass clippings and yard debris at home **or** at the Amherst Transfer Station.
